What is the Luther Village Fund?

The Luther Village Fund is an endowment fund. It is an accumulation of financial gifts which will generate interest income to be disbursed towards worthy projects and causes at Luther Village. The Luther Village Fund exists to encourage lasting contributions from individuals and organizations which will support the camp by funding capital projects, enhancing programming and providing financial assistance through camperships.

- Only interest income generated from the Luther Village Fund will be spent, the principal will always remain intact so that the Luther Village Fund will do good things at Luther Village forever
- The Luther Village Fund will exclusively support 3 key areas: capital projects, enhancing programming and financial assistance through camperships. Interest income will never be spent on general operations.
- The Winnipeg Foundation will manage the endowment fund on behalf of Luther Village. This
 means The Winnipeg Foundation will be responsible for receiving donations, purchasing,
 selling and holding investments within the Luther Village Fund, making available fund related
 information to Luther Village and distributing interest income.

We are seeking seed contributions to start up this fund. Our goal is \$700,000.

Why an endowment fund?

Endowment funds are useful vehicles that provide regular financial support to various types of non-profit and charitable organizations. A large number of universities, private schools, hospitals and even summer camps create endowment funds to support their programs, build new facilities, and purchase new equipment. The benefits of such a fund to Luther VIllage would be no different and would allow us to do many great things!

- Upgrade, renovate and build new cabins and facilities
- Improve our grounds, such as newer boat docks, better roads and improved drainage, greener sporting fields

- Purchase new equipment, such as fishing boats, vehicles, major appliances, maintenance and kitchen equipment
- Enhance programming, through the purchase of kayaks, camera and video equipment for the Performing Arts Camp and a paved basketball court, to name a few options
- Strengthen our campership programs and create a new Lutheran Urban Ministry campership to bring inner city youth and families out to camp

In addition, with proper planning, an endowment fund will eliminate the need to conduct last minute capital campaigns to address capital crises

The Campaign to create the Luther Village Fund

Why \$700,000?

\$700,000 would get us off to a great start! At a projected interest rate of 4%, the fund would generate \$28,000 per year, which would provide sufficient funds to undertake the projects we have planned and the projects we will dream.

Proceeds from the Luther Village Fund will only be allocated to three areas, capital projects, enhancing programming and providing financial assistance through camperships. For the first few years of the fund we plan to direct the proceeds to select projects.



A-frame renovations

Comfortable and inviting cabins are key to the Luther Village experience. All of our A-Frame cabins are showing their age and are in need of upgrades. Proceeds from the Luther Village Fund will be allocated to renovating our A-Frame cabins so that they will offer a warm and inviting environment for all of our campers. Some possible improvements include:

- New flooring and brighter walls will offer a warm, clean feel to the cabin
- New countertops and sinks will provide a freshened and more modern look to the kitchen
- New vanities and fixtures, will provide a much needed updated look to the washrooms
- New furniture and decor will create a comfortable and inviting space

Campership Program

Summer camps provide a unique opportunity for people of all ages to meet new friends, develop positive values, understand the importance of healthy communities, and to gain a positive view of the world and their place in it.

Low income should never be a barrier preventing people from experiencing camp. Everyone, regardless of income level, should have the opportunity to attend and experience camp. Proceeds from the Luther Village Fund will be used to bolster and expand the campership program to ensure that everyone who would like to attend and experience Luther Village receives that opportunity.

FAMILY & YOUTH CAMPERSHIPS

A revamped family and youth campership program will provide up to a 90% financial subsidy to help send families and youth to Luther Village.

LUTHERAN URBAN MINISTRY CAMPERSHIPS

Thanks to a partnership with Lutheran Urban Ministry, a new campership program will provide a 100% financial subsidy to help send inner city families and youth to Luther Village.

New kayaks, canoes & storage facility

Luther Village is blessed to be located on such a beautiful lake and new watercraft will enable our campers to take part in lake-based recreational pursuits. In particular the addition of a fleet of kayaks will allow us to offer group kayaking activities. New canoes will permit us to replace many of our existing aging and well used canoes. In addition a new storage facility to place our kayaks and canoes will not only protect these watercraft from the elements but from theft during the winter season.

Additional resources for the Performing Arts Camp

Our Performing Arts Camp has been very well received and we would like that to continue. By purchasing camera and video equipment, camcorders and software we will ensure that we provide up to date tools to our budding young artists and continue to attract youth to this excellent program.

An expanded dining hall will provide Luther Village with the ability to accommodate more campers during meal times and will provide much needed alternate meeting space.


Fully accessible Chapel and campfire pit


Your financial gift is really worth more
